


CLEAN-UP GUIDELINES



- Horticultural (plant) waste cleanup strictly within World of Plants section. Cleanup <u>outside</u> of World of Plants is <u>NOT</u> allowed.
- Only for Gardens By the Bay that mostly horticultural (plant) waste will be collected, since there isn't as many general wastes as possible to be collected in the gardens most of the time.
- General or large bins can be found near the public toilets at Supertree Grove and near the Flower Dome.
- Participants should not step into any planters as there might be algae and sharp lava rocks to prevent any skips and falls

CLEAN-UP GUIDELINES



- Do not venture into any bushes or higher areas that are beyond reach
- Cutting or taking any plants from the Gardens is not allowed
- Do not to touch any unfamiliar plant as it may have thorns or plant sap that can cause injuries or allergies. If exposed, quickly proceed to wash the affected area thoroughly and seek assistance from GBB staff at the ticketing counters
- Refrain from approaching animals like the monitor lizards, snakes, and otters; Keep their distance

IMPORTANT GUIDELINES

Segregate trash

Horti Waste (canvas bag)

Fallen leaves, fruits, flowers, small branches



Put in jumbo canvas bag only

Regular Waste (trash bag)

Cans, Plastics, Paper, etc.




Throw in trash bin



IMPORTANT GUIDELINES DO NOT pick up the ff:

- Insects and animals (dead or alive)
- Leaves, flowers, fruits that are still on the plants/trees
- Branches that are still attached to the plant/tree

Decoration on the plants/trees





WHAT TO BRING

Members:

- Drinking water
- Umbrella / poncho / hat / cap
- Sunscreen
- Sunglasses
- Wipes: Towel / tissue

Note:

Feel free to bring other essentials your family needs

EP will provide:

- Cotton gloves
- Antibac Wet wipes
- Cooling spray
- Trash bag
- Mosquito repellent sachet

BAY CLEANPOD ACCESS (MANCOMM)

Upon completion of cleanup,

- Place Jumbo Canvas bags with horti wastes neatly in front of CleanPod;
 GB Ops staff will collect after the event
- Dry clean the tongs and pails: ensure no collection of water on the tongs and pails
- Return all items to the CleanPod,
 lock it and turn the number to '5555'.



BAY CLEANPOD ACCESS (MANCOMM)

- Press the number lock to 5555 to unlock the lock.
- In the shed:
 - 2 wagons or garden carts
 - 100 metal tongs (approx.)
 - 30-40 pails for trash
 - 5 white canvas jumbo bags for plant (provided when necessary)
- We will only borrow tongs and likely jumbo canvas bag and wagon
- After locking the CleanPod, the person in charge must photograph the secured pod and send the image via WhatsApp to **98359194** for confirmation.
